October 23, 1960 Baltimore, Maryland, USA

Bachelor's degree, Computer Science, Brown University, 1982

Ph.D, Computer Science, Carnegie Mellon University, 1988

He was granted tenure one year early in University of Virginia, 1988-1997

Professor of computer science and humancomputer interaction and design, Carnegie Mellon University

Five books and over 60 papers (author or coauthor)
